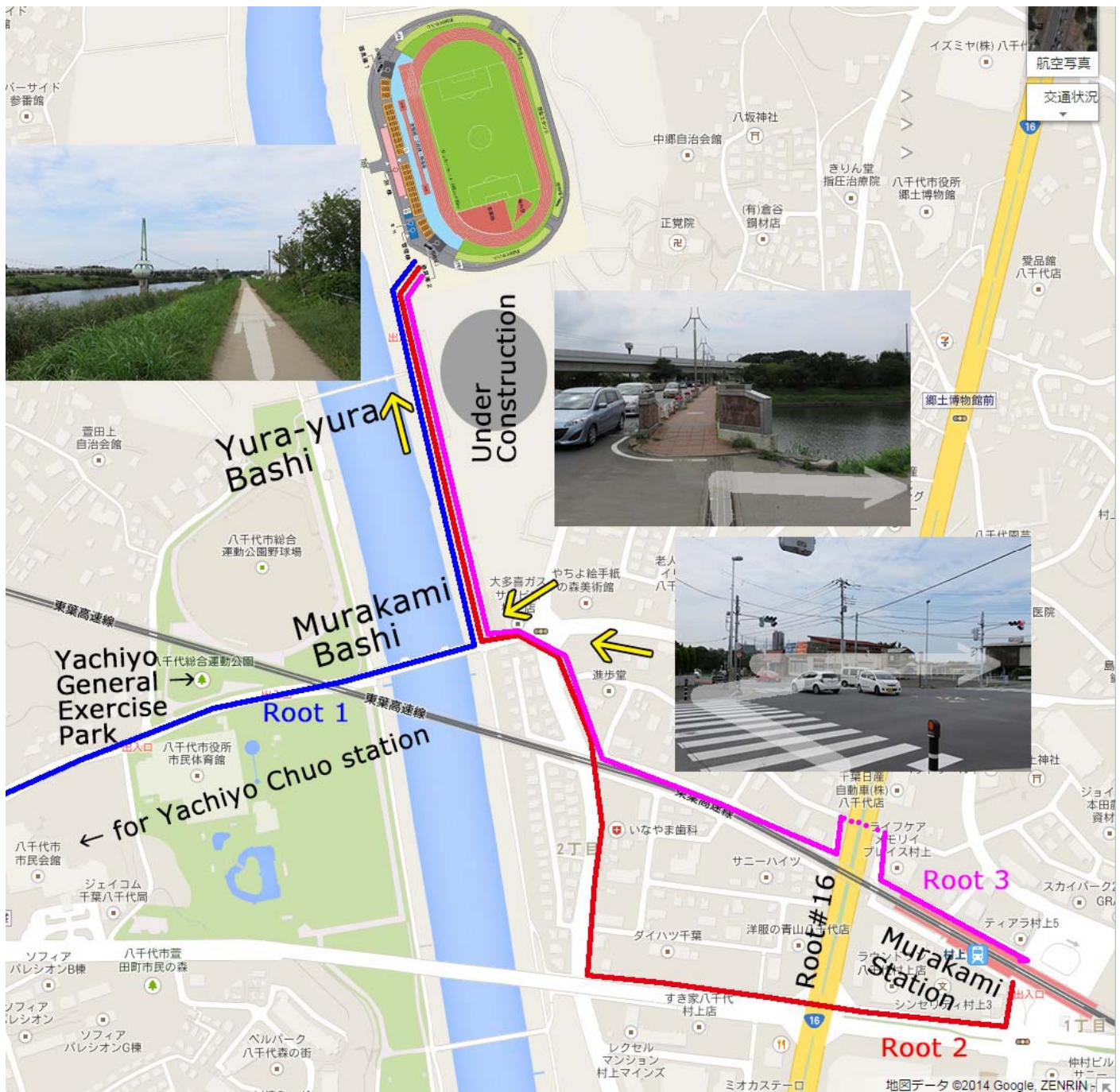


Root Guide for “IBM BigBlue vs. Nojima Sagamihara RISE”

We recommend you to utilize the one of the following three roots, one from the Yachiyo-Chuo station and two from the Murakami station on the Toyo Rapid Railway line (Toyo Kohsoku Tetsudo), for accessing the venue of the game on September 27th (Saturday).



1. Root 1: From the Yachiyo-Chuo station on the Toyo Rapid Railway line (Toyo Kohsoku Tetsudo)
 - A) Get off at the Yachiyo-Chuo station and walk toward “Yachiyo General Exercise Park”. You may use a public bus or taxi.
 - B) Cross the “Murakami-Bashi” (bridge) then turn to the left. Walk along the river toward the north (upside on the above map).
 - C) When you pass the “Yura-yura Bashi” (bridge), you will see the venue on the right side. It takes approximately 20 minutes on walk from the station.
2. Root 2: From the Murakami station on the Toyo Rapid Railway line (1 of 2)
 - A) Go out from the station and turn to the right. You will see the crossing in front of “Itoh Yohkado Yachio Store”. Don’t pass the crossing but the turn to the right at the crossing.
 - B) You will see “Murakami Danchi Entrance” crossing. Go straight the crossing.

- C) Go the side walk so you go down to the crossing road. Turn to the right at the crossing.
 - D) You will pass under the Toyo Rapid Railway line. At the next crossing, turn to the left.
 - E) You will soon find the “Murakami Bashi” (bridge). Turn to the right at the bridge and walk along the river.
 - F) When you pass the “Yura-yura Bashi” (bridge), you will see the venue on the right side. It takes approximately 18 minutes on walk.
3. Root 3: From the Murakami station on the Toyo Rapid Railway line (2 of 2)
- A) Go out from the station and turn to the left. Walk along the Toyo Rapid Railway line toward the Yachiyo-Chuo station.
 - B) When you reach the bank of the Road #16, you will find the tunnel at the right side. Pass the tunnel then go back to the left. Keep walking along the railway line toward the Yachiyo-Chuo station.
 - C) When you reach the crossing under the railway line, turn to the right. Turn to the left at the next crossing.
 - D) You will soon find the “Murakami Bashi” (bridge). Turn to the right at the bridge and walk along the river.
 - E) When you pass the “Yura-yura Bashi” (bridge), you will see the venue on the right side. It takes approximately 15 minutes on walk.

The city library and related buildings are under construction around the venue. Please be advised for the following matters.

1. No parking space is available around the venue. No transportation service is scheduled to/from the venue. Please utilize the public transportation service to the neighborhood and access to the venue on walk as guided above.
2. None of food/drink shops and convenience stores is available around the venue. However a temporary service by LAWSON will be available in the venue at the game day. Yachiyo City’s character “Yacchi” goods will be also available.
3. All of stand areas are open space. According to the game day’s weather condition, please prepare equipments and wears in advance.
4. As the game host team, BigBlue team area will be placed at the main stand side. Toward the field, the left side of main stand will be Nojima Sagamihara’s area and the right side will be BigBlue’s area.
5. Please check the Toyo Raid Railway’s top page (<http://www.toyokosoku.co.jp/en>) for the train schedule and more details.
 - A) Toyo Rapid Railway provides the through train service with Tokyo Metro Tozai-line (East-West line) at the Nishi Funabashi station. For instance, a Tozai-line train arrives at the Nishi Funabashi station goes through the Toyo Rapid Railway line and vice versa.
 - B) The Toyo Rapid Railway line will be serviced every 15 minutes when the game is held.
 - C) At the Nishi Funabashi station on the Toyo Rapid Railway line, you can transfer to/from the JR Soubu-line, the JR Keiyoh-line and the JR Musashino-line from/to the Toyo Rapid Railway line.
 - D) At the Toyo Katsutadai station (the end of Toyo Rapid Railway line), you can transfer to/from the Keisei Main-line.

The Japanese Drumming group “KOGMIX” (<http://www.kogmix.com/saito/KOGMIX.html>) will perform in the half time show. KOGMIX is the group consists of OB and OG of the local Yachiyo High-school’s drum club “KO-GUMI”. In addition, post-game event for children on and under twelve will be held (till around 17:00). They will have opportunities to do ball catch with players, dance with cheerleaders and take memorial photos with players and cheerleaders. It will be very valuable time for children!
